


## PILS

Straw-coloured, very clear, with a creamy, long-lasting white head. The bitterness is distinct, but short. The aroma comes from light malt combined with noble hops from Germany and Czech Republic. It is a very classic, everyday beer.





#### AMERICAN BEAUTY

Bitter but well-balanced, light yet aromatic; instead of knocking you off your feet, it will serve to unwind and perk you up. Cheerful citrus, mango and lychee on the nose. Crisp, light, moderately bitter and fruity, very drinkable.





### CALIFIA


Dry, bitter but very, very aromatic. A citrusy bomb of fragrances: grapefruit, oranges, lemons and limes, followed by a nice balanced malt sweetness.






### PAN IPANI


The best of two worlds: the lightness of wheat beers combined with the enticing bitterness of a classic IPA. Citrus, mango and pear aromas intertwined with delicate floral notes.





# GOEDEMORGEN

Peaches and oranges, swiftly followed by spicy pepper and herbs. Then lemons and grapefruit combined by biscuits and caramel aroma. Bold, yet crisp and brief bitterness.





### BLACKCYL

Wafts of pine, resin, grapefruit and herbs, all subtly complemented by malty, chocolatey notes. Dry and strongly bitter.
